Dear Parents/Carers

Almost without exception, parents and staff feel that school uniform is the cheapest and most sensible form of working dress in a school. We hope that all parents will support us fully in providing their children with the correct uniform, including footwear.

After consulting with a cross age group of parents on our school uniform the following has been decided for uniform for the coming years.

Day to day uniform

Short/long dark grey trousers, grey tunic or skirt, white polo-shirt or white shirt/blouse, school sweatshirt, sweatcardi, school fleece, or royal blue 'V' neck pullover, or cardigan, grey or white socks, black shoes, plain black sandals with a closed toe and back, plain laces not trainers or boots. Royal-blue or yellow checked skirts or dresses are permitted in the summer months.

No designer emblems on tops.

Long hair should be tied back with **small plain hair bands or clips only – no hair bows or ornate clips**. Long hair must be tied back during all P.E. activities. Extreme hairstyles i.e. shaved emblems, Mohican/styles with severe variations in length, nail varnish or false nails are not permitted.

PE/Games uniform

We will be continuing to allow the children to come to school in their PE kits next year, however it has been agreed that this could look smarter, we are therefore reintroducing an expectation for PE uniform. PE/Games uniform will consist of the following; either black or dark blue shorts and jogging bottoms (this expectation has not altered), a T-shirt and sweatshirt linked to your child's House colour, a pair of plimsolls and trainers for outdoors. Children will work in bare feet in the hall, unless there is medical reason for footwear to be worn. Plimsolls are still needed.

Our uniform is available to be ordered on-line from School Trends; <http://www.schooltrends.co.uk/> along with other school related items, TFS (Togs for Sprogs) in Dartford or from a local supermarket – in order to help minimise costs uniform does not all need to be branded with the school logo.



Clothing for PE/Games can also be ordered using the links below and house coloured sweatshirts and T-shirts are reasonably inexpensive at about £10 in total for both.


