Headteacher's Message

In our last newsletter, I started it by asking parents to be mindful of taking concerns that their children sometimes bring home too literally as on occasions, a pupil's interpretation of an event may not always be what has happened. It is always important to keep an open mind until facts can be established.

In an attempt to be 'light-hearted' about an important issue, that sometimes causes distress to others, and additional workload for staff, I may have given the false impression that we do not want you to take children's 'disclosures' seriously. This is not the case. It is also not the case that pupils regularly disclose things about their parents that we ignore. Whilst we do, occasionally, receive information that we may have to follow up I would not want you to think that this is a common issue. We always want children to feel safe when talking about issues and events that are significant to them and have many avenues in place in order to facilitate this. As a school, (and as an individual), children's concerns and disclosures are always taken seriously. We will always listen to what pupils tell us and then take appropriate action if required.

Furthermore, can I reiterate that, if there is an issue that you feel does need following up, then please, ALWAYS speak to the class teacher first and foremost, in a calm and respectful manner.

Thank you for your understanding with this matter and helping us promote a positive relationship between pupils, parents and staff.

Staff are not able to remove the children's earrings for them or tape them. If your child is wearing earrings on their PE day, and they are not taped, then they will not be able to take part.

School Uniform – Please can you ensure that your child is wearing their correct school uniform every day. Please note that trainers are not allowed – appropriate school shoes should be worn unless advised by your teacher.
